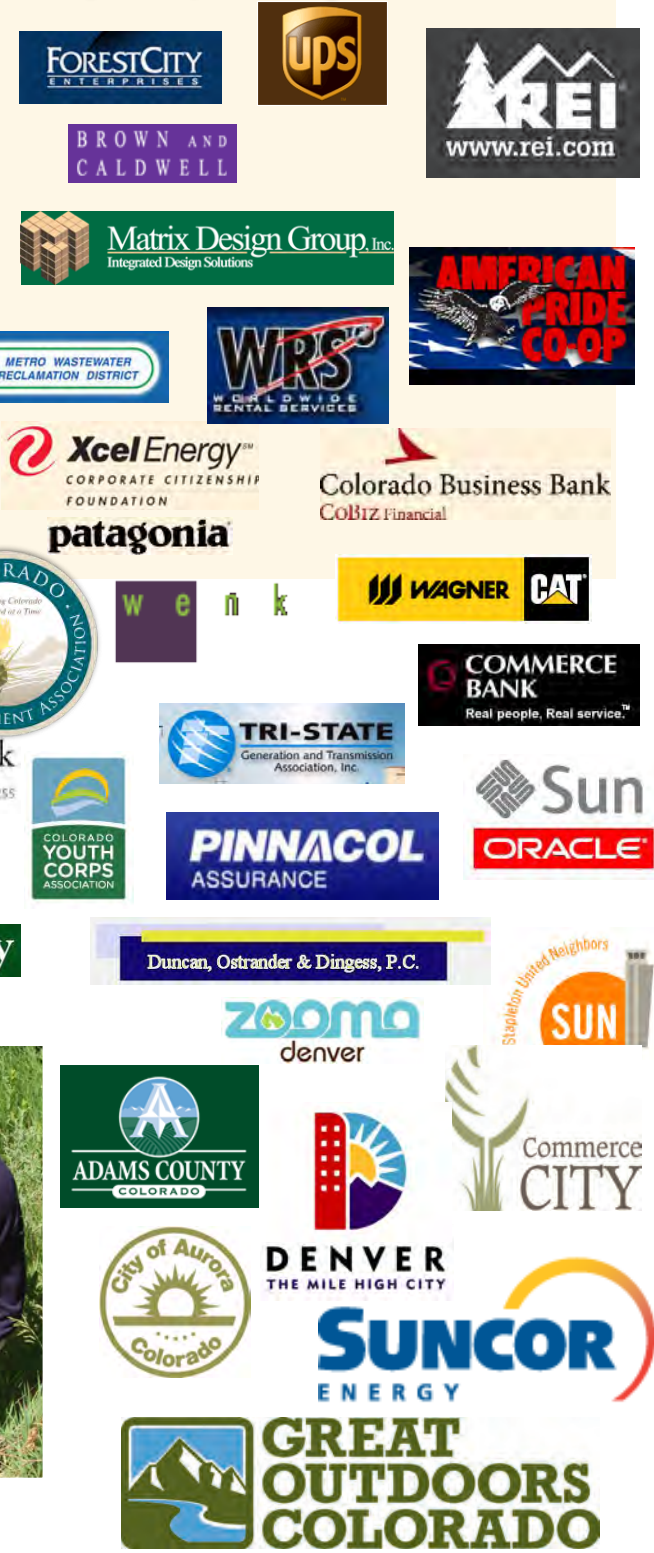

Dear Friends of the Sand Creek Regional Greenway Partnership:

Did you know that the Denver Metro Region is ranked 12th among 51 large U.S. metropolitan areas for the rate of its volunteer efforts? Here at SCRGP, we know it...because we're continually delighted by the volunteer support we receive for projects that expand and enhance the Sand Creek Regional Greenway!

This past year was our biggest yet for volunteer support. With the help of major corporate and institutional supporters including Suncor, REI, UPS, AmeriCorp, NCCC, Pinnacle Assurance, area schools and neighborhood organizations, we've tackled expanses of invasive weeds and replaced them with local species...we've protected cottonwoods and other native trees from natural predators...we've improved stretches of finished trail along our 14-mile expanse...we've removed graffiti from the former runway tunnels at Stapleton...and we're continuing the task of cleaning litter from the trail and its surroundings.

In the course of those volunteer projects, we've created new friends for the Greenway and its beautiful expanses of 'Wilderness in the City.'
